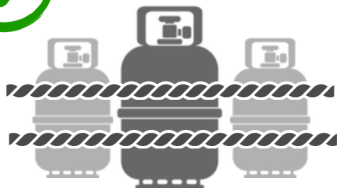




Handling refrigerants *safely*

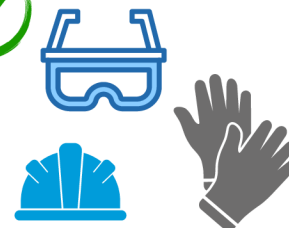

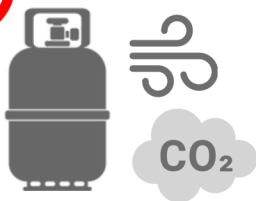
Always fasten cylinders securely or use cage when transporting



Always consult the MSDS and hold appropriate refrigerant training certification



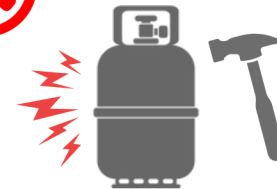
Avoid burns, correct PPE must be worn at all times



Prevent pollution - ensure valves are completely closed



Keep away from heat sources to prevent explosions or safety valve damage



Avoid impact on any cylinders and always handle with care to avoid irreversible damage



Completing the **cylinder collection** request form

We need to know:

- Collection address plus contact name and number on site.
- Preferred collection date – this will be confirmed once raised.
- Details of any special site requirements, eg tail lift, pallet truck, vehicle size or weight restrictions.
- If cylinders are currently loose, caged or palletised (please palletise where possible)
- Cylinder quantity - total for each size of cylinder.
- List of all 8 digit barcode numbers.

For reclaim or receiver cylinders (green tops), we also need:

- Product in cylinder.
- List of cylinder numbers.
- Weight for each cylinder number.

If necessary, we complete the Hazardous waste note on your behalf and send you a copy.
